

# **Lay Leadership Roles on Sunday Morning**

## **Religious Education Teacher or Assistant**

Teach or assist in the PreK or K-5 Religious Education classes during the 11:00am Worship Service. Teachers sit with the children as they are called up front for the story time at the start of Worship, then walk with them back to their classroom. Time commitment is approximately two hours per week – one hour of planning and one hour on Sunday morning.

## **Fellowship Greeter**

Welcome newcomers and members alike as they arrive for the Worship Service on Sunday morning. Provide basic information about the Fellowship, answer questions, and generally make folks feel welcome.

## **Usher**

Assist with logistics in the Fellowship Hall during Worship. Make sure the Orders of Service are set out, pass the baskets for Offertory collection, hand out yellow slips for written Joys and Concerns.

## **Sound Board Operator**

Set up the sound equipment and the headset board prior to Worship. Sit at the sound board and monitor sound, adjusting as needed, during the Worship. Record the Service on cd, label and file the cd after Service. Put away sound equipment after Service.

## **Worship Leader**

Serve in the pulpit with the Minister to help guide the Worship Service. Provide a welcoming face and presence for the Service and guide the congregation through the elements of Worship as listed in the Order of Service. May require communication with the Minister or guest speaker prior to the Sunday Service.

## **Choir Member**

Under the direction of our Music Director, Mignon Dobbins, the choir performs at least twice a month during the program year and practices on Wednesday nights.
